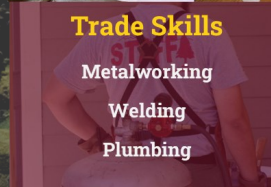

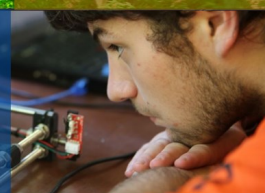

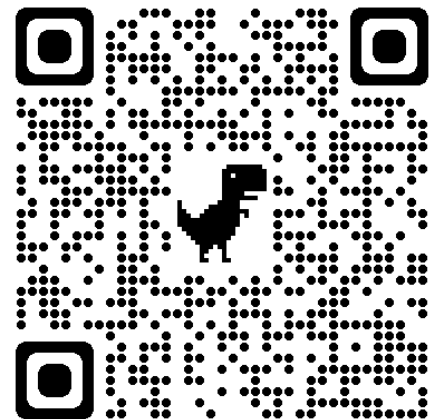
Camp Staff
